

**EXCELLENT AND RARE DIAMONDS TO FEATURE IN PHILLIPS de PURY & COMPANY  
MAGNIFICENT JEWELS SALE TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 14, 2006 IN GENEVA**

November 1 – Geneva – Phillips de Pury & Company's Magnificent Jewels sale will feature some of the most beautiful and rare diamond jewelry creations of recent times. The sale will be held on November 14 at 4:30 pm at Hotel de la Paix, 11 Quai du Mont-Blanc 1201 in Geneva.

Highlights of the sale include:

***A Magnificent Diamond Necklace*** by **Graff** (CHF 340,000-450,000), the front designed as four rows of slightly graduated circular-cut diamonds, joined at the shoulders with articulated baguette-cut diamond scrolls, with a tapering three row circular-cut diamond backchain, mounted in platinum.

***A Magnificent Emerald and Diamond Necklace*** (CHF 400,000–500,000), the front enhanced with two pear-shaped emeralds weighing approximately 20.17 and 19.72 carats, set within a circular-cut diamond surround.

***A Magnificent Diamond Ring*** (CHF 260,000-320,000), set with a rectangular-cut fancy orange-brown diamond weighing approximately 20.60 carats, with a gallery and four row hoop entirely set with circular-cut diamonds, mounted in platinum. Diamonds of this type and size exhibiting a superior quality are very rare. These Type IIA diamonds have been unearthed from a limited number of sources from around the world (e.g., South Africa, Brazil, Russia and India) and are known from their extreme purity and limpidity, qualities compared so often throughout history to pure crystallized water.

***An Important Diamond Necklace*** (CHF 200,000 – 300,000), enhanced in the front by a pear-shaped diamond weighing approximately 4.12 carats, within a circular-cut diamond surround, mounted in platinum.

***A Rare Fancy Pink Diamond Ring*** (CHF 2,000,000-2,450,000), set with a fancy pink diamond weighing approximately 9.11 carats, within a circular-cut diamond surround. The gallery and hoop are entirely decorated with circular-cut diamonds.

***A Magnificent Sapphire Ring*** (CHF 200,000-295,000), set to the center with an oval-cut sapphire weighing approximately 53.19 carats, with kite-shaped diamond and pavé-set diamond shoulders, mounted in platinum.

***An Exquisite Suite of Diamond Jewelry*** (CHF 550,000-750,000) comprising a necklace and matching ear pendants. The front of the necklace is composed of a graduated series of nine fancy color and colored radiant-cut diamonds weighing approximately 48.21 carats in total, within a circular-cut and pear-shaped diamond surround, mounted in platinum.

***A Magnificent Diamond Ring*** (CHF 935,000-1,000,000), set with a radiant-cut diamond weighing approximately 20.61 carats, flanked on either side by a kite-shaped diamond, mounted in platinum.

***A Magnificent Pair of Diamond Earrings*** (CHF 150,000-175,000), each designed as a pear-shaped rose-cut diamond within a circular-cut diamond surround, suspended from a cushion-cut diamond surmount, mounted in gold and silver.

***An Art Deco Diamond Bracelet***, circa 1930 (CHF 70,000-80,000), designed as two pierced openwork panels entirely set with old-cut diamonds and enhanced with a central line of larger graduated old-cut diamonds, joined with buckle-shaped diamond-link spacers, mounted in platinum.

The viewing will commence on Friday, November 10 from 12 - 7 pm and thereafter:  
Saturday, November 11 from 10 am - 7 pm; Sunday November 12 from 10 am - 7 pm; Monday, November 13 from 10 am - 8 pm and Tuesday, November 14 from 10 am until the sale.

There will be an opening reception on Monday, November 13 from 12 - 8 pm.
